Dr Richard Rose is Professor Emeritus in Inclusive Education at the University of Northampton, UK. He has conducted research for international agencies including UNICEF, The Commonwealth Commission, ACCESS (Australia) and Sightsavers, for National Government bodies in UK, Ireland, Norway and Malta and for charitable trusts. He has worked regularly in India for more than 20 years on research and development projects and in supporting novice researchers in the acquisition of research competencies. He is the author of more than 100 academic publications and has presented keynote lectures at international conferences in many parts of the world.



Dr. Jayanthi Narayan is a Special Educator, currently a visiting Professor of Inclusive Education, Faculty of Health, Education and Society, at the University of Northampton, UK.

She has retired as the Deputy Director of the National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Intellectual Disabilities (NIEPID), Government of India. She completed her post-graduation from the State University of New York, USA specializing in Education (Learning disabilities and Mental retardation). She holds another M.A. in Education and Ph.D.



Dr Ratika Malkani has over two decades of experience in education. For the last ten years she has focussed on inclusive education and social research.

Her area of interest is in researching the educational opportunities available for young people with special educational needs and those from socially and economically deprived backgrounds. Her recent investigations have included research into transition to adulthood for young people with disabilities, a study of first generation learners in Maharashtra and development work in Telangana. Ratika's work has been published in a number of international journals and books.
